Children's Disability Register



The SEND Local Offer provides information for children and young people aged 0 - 25 with SEND. It includes information about mainstream and specialist Send Local Offer education, health and care provision, accessible and inclusive activities, support services and post-16 education and training opportunities. The Disability register is a database that holds information about children and young people who live in Redcar and Cleveland. The Children's Act 1989 **Children and Young** required us to keep a register. This register helps us to plan and develop services People's Disability for children and young people with disabilities, it helps us know who we have have, where they are and what they may need support to support them. In Register addition to planning, the register also help us to involve and inform families as well as keep in touch to share news and updates about services.
