

We have now sent Parent and Carer surveys to the participating schools to forward on to families. We would ask as many parents and carers to complete the survey as possible before Friday 10th May.

This survey helps us to produce an Action Plan for the PINS Project which will be implemented in the schools. This will also shape how we aim to engage with parents and school staff and work towards building positive relationships.

Following this schools, will complete a self assessment evaluation which will highlight any support they can access from the PINS Project.

As a forum our aim is to attend monthly meetings with parents, carers and school staff to provide support and guidance.



In addition we also have some availability on our fully funded 10 week SEND Forest School


